Zahra Noorbakhsh is a feminist Muslim satirist and Iranian-American comedian. *The New Yorker* magazine dubbed her one-woman show *All Atheists Are Muslim* a highlight of the International New York City Fringe Theater Festival, the largest multi-arts festival in North America. She is a contributor to *The New York Times*-featured anthology, *Love Inshallah: The Secret Love Lives of American Muslim Women*. She continues to write for *LoveInshallah.com* in her monthly column,

entitled *My Infidel Husband*. Noorbakhsh is also cohost of the internationally acclaimed podcast, *#GoodMuslimBadMuslim*. Recently, Noorbakhsh was a featured comic at the Muslim Funny Fest's Comedy All Stars showcase, at the renowned Comic Strip in New York City.
