Zahra Noorbakhsh is a feminist Muslim satirist and Iranian-American comedian. The New Yorker magazine dubbed her one-woman show All Atheists Are Muslim a highlight of the International New York City Fringe Theater Festival, the largest multi-arts festival in North America. She is a contributor to The New York Times-featured anthology, Love Inshallah: The Secret Love Lives of American Muslim Women. She continues to write for LoveInshallah.com in her monthly column,

entitled My Infidel Husband. Noorbakhsh is also cohost of the internationally acclaimed podcast, #GoodMuslimBadMuslim. Recently, Noorbakhsh was a featured comic at the Muslim Funny Fest's Comedy All Stars showcase, at the renowned Comic Strip in New York City. 
